

Statement of Purpose

As provided in Article Two of the bylaws, the purpose of the Foundation is as follows:

This Foundation is organized, and shall be administered and operated, exclusively to receive, administer, and expend funds for the following charitable and educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986:

- (a) education and training for health professionals;
- (b) the conduct of studies and research;
- (c) collaboration with related organizations and the broad dissemination of public and professional information;
- (d) other educational and charitable activity as determined by the Board of Trustees;
- (e) to assist other educational and charitable organizations in the conduct of similar activities; and
- (f) to engage in any and all lawful activities incidental to the foregoing purposes except as restricted herein.

Program Highlights

The Foundation continued all existing programs while adding new ones during the 2006-2007 operating year.

The Anchor and Caduceus Committee of the PHS Commissioned Officers Foundation for the Advancement of Public Health organized and sponsored the 2007 Anchor and Caduceus Dinner commemorating the founding of the PHS Commissioned Corps in 1889. The highlight of the dinner was the Dr. C. Everett Koop Honorary Lecture delivered by The Honorable Richard A. Carmona, M.D., M.P.H., F.A.C.S., 17th Surgeon General of the U.S. Public Health Service. Dr. Carmona was introduced by Dr. C. Everett Koop. The event was an opportunity for several organizations to recognize Dr. Carmona's service as Surgeon General including the Association of Medical Surgeons of the United States (AMSUS) and the Uniformed Services University of Health Sciences.

In June 2007 the Foundation sponsored the Global Health Summit II- *Improving Health and Safety through Diplomacy*, in Cincinnati, Ohio. The Summit provided an excellent opportunity to raise awareness about various services and activities among more than 400 thought leaders and decision-makers in global health. Presenters included both the Australian Surgeon General and former U.S. Surgeon General Carmona. Attendees included leaders from both academia as well as domestic and foreign health care agencies.

The Global Health Summit II was followed by the four-day annual USPHS Scientific and Training Symposium sponsored by the PHS Commissioned Officers Foundation for the Advancement of Public Health. The Summit and Symposium attracted some 800 attendees.

The Foundation continued one of its most important programs, funding the symposium registration fee for approximately 100 junior officers – a \$30,000 investment in the future leaders of the PHS Commissioned Corps

Following the Symposium the Foundation continued the global health initiative by meeting with and signing a Memorandum of Agreement with the Chinese Association of Health Educators committing both organizations to seek opportunities for collaboration on projects promoting their mutual interests in public health education initiatives. A formal signing ceremony was conducted on Capitol Hill in Washington, DC by Rear Admiral Mary Pat Couig, USPHS (Ret.), Foundation President, and Doctor Liu Keling, Association President.

As a tribute to the founding Foundation President, Rear Admiral Jerrold M. Michael, USPHS (Ret.) on his 80th Birthday, The PHS Commissioned Officers Foundation established a Fellowship program named in his honor. This program will provide financial assistance to officers of the Commissioned Corps pursuing advanced degrees in public health.

As the Foundation grows and becomes more widely known, a direct result is greater awareness, understanding, and support for the PHS Commissioned Corps and its

role in protecting and advancing not only the Nation's public health, but also the health of the global community.

ANNUAL USPHS SCIENTIFIC AND TRAINING SYMPOSIUM

The Foundation assumed full responsibility for sponsoring the 2007 Annual USPHS Scientific and Training Symposium. The 42nd annual Conference, with the theme, *The Many faces of Public Health*, held in Cincinnati, Ohio from June 3-7. With more than 100 exhibitors and a superb scientific program, this event demonstrates the Foundation's commitment to providing programs of high value and utility not only for PHS commissioned officers, but also for all public health professionals.

Highlights of the 2007 Symposium included the Luther Terry Memorial Lecture delivered by RADM William Craig Vanderwagen, USPHS, Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. RADM Vanderwagen discussed the role of Corps officers as an essential element of the nation's public health response. The Closing Keynote address was presented by RADM Kenneth Moritsugu, USPHS, Acting Surgeon General. He outlined the several components of national health security in the context of the Surgeon General's Public Health Priorities.

The 2008 Public Health Service Scientific and Training Symposium will be held in Tucson, AZ, June 8-12, 2008.
